

Multiple Unit Developments – Better Practice



- In 2016/17 WALGA developed Better Practice Guidance to increase Resource Recovery from MUDs
- This was focused largely on recycling, not GO or FOGO
- The Guidelines were piloted with the Cities of Perth, Vincent and Stirling.
- Fast forward.... August 2020 formed FOGO in MUDs Working Group (WMRC, EMRC, Stirling, Kalamunda, Bunbury, Vincent, Vic Park, Collie, SMRC and Rockingham)
- September 2020 Submitted a Waste Sorted Grant application to update WALGA Guidance and develop a Better Practice Guideline which includes FOGO, pilot the Guidelines and develop a waste generation calculator.



- Identify and contact the Strata Company with responsibility for the MDD.
- Identify the current levels of service provision to the MDD and how this service is being used (identify bins and contamination)
- Identify language groups in the area the MDD is located and other demographic factors which may influence the engagement approaches undertaken (demographics)



• Identify the suite of approaches needed for **engagement**.
