



FOGO is a GO-GO from 26 July 2021

From 26 July, Albany's household bin collection is going FOGO!

This means that you'll be able to put your food scraps and other organic material along with your garden prunings into your lime-green lidded FOGO bin, which will be collected for processing into compost.

Currently about 30% of the contents of Albany's general waste bins are food and organics, so going FOGO means we can divert waste away from landfill and recycle it instead.





Your bin day will remain the same, however, when FOGO starts all bins will be collected on a fortnightly schedule.

How do we know if it's worked?

- A full review will be undertaken 12-months post FOGO implementation, but this is what we've found so far:
 - FOGO system has been embraced by the community high presentation rates, lots of FOGO waste collected and very low contamination rates
 - Most people are managing with the reduced general waste collection, but there is still more work to do
 - Some fluctuations in the recycling contamination rates we will need a full year of data to properly assess this
